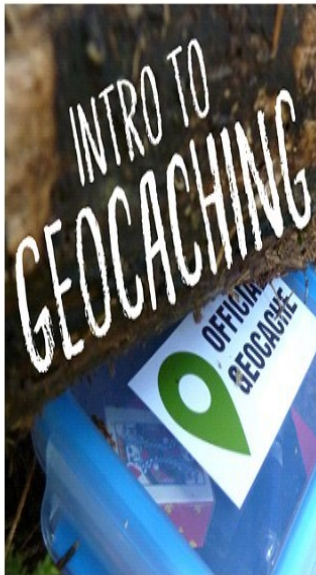

## *Intro to Geocaching*

**Date:** Saturday, July 27<sup>th</sup>

**Time:** 9:00 to 11:00AM

**Location:** Cook Conservation Area (off Route 70)

Do you enjoy Hiking? Nature? A good treasure hunt? You might want to try your hand at geocaching. During this 2-hour long program you and your family will be introduced to the world of Geocaching. Geocaching is sort of an outdoor game of hide-and-seek. Geocaching is played using a GPS enabled device, such as a handheld GPS or smartphone, to point to a set of GPS coordinates. Once you are close to the coordinates you have to use your wits to discover the “hide.” This is a fun activity your entire family can enjoy together almost anywhere with over 2.5 million geocaches hidden throughout the world! Please join the Lancaster Recreation Committee at Cook Conservation Area on July 27<sup>th</sup> to start your adventure!

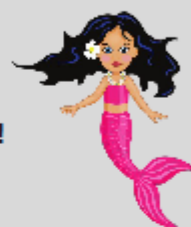
