Following lunch we travel to the scenic Essex River for a trip along the Ct. Coast by Steam Train and River Boat. Then it gets even better! We return to ride the Essex Steam Train & Riverboat's journey begins at the historic 1892 Essex Station for a narrated round-trip into the heart of the unspoiled Connecticut River Valley. The steam locomotive pulls vintage coaches through the quintessential New England towns of Deep River and Chester. A natural highlight is the undeveloped Selden Neck State Park, accessible only by boat. Essex Steam Train offers unique access to several coves and preserves, immersing passengers in an on-board eco-excursion. 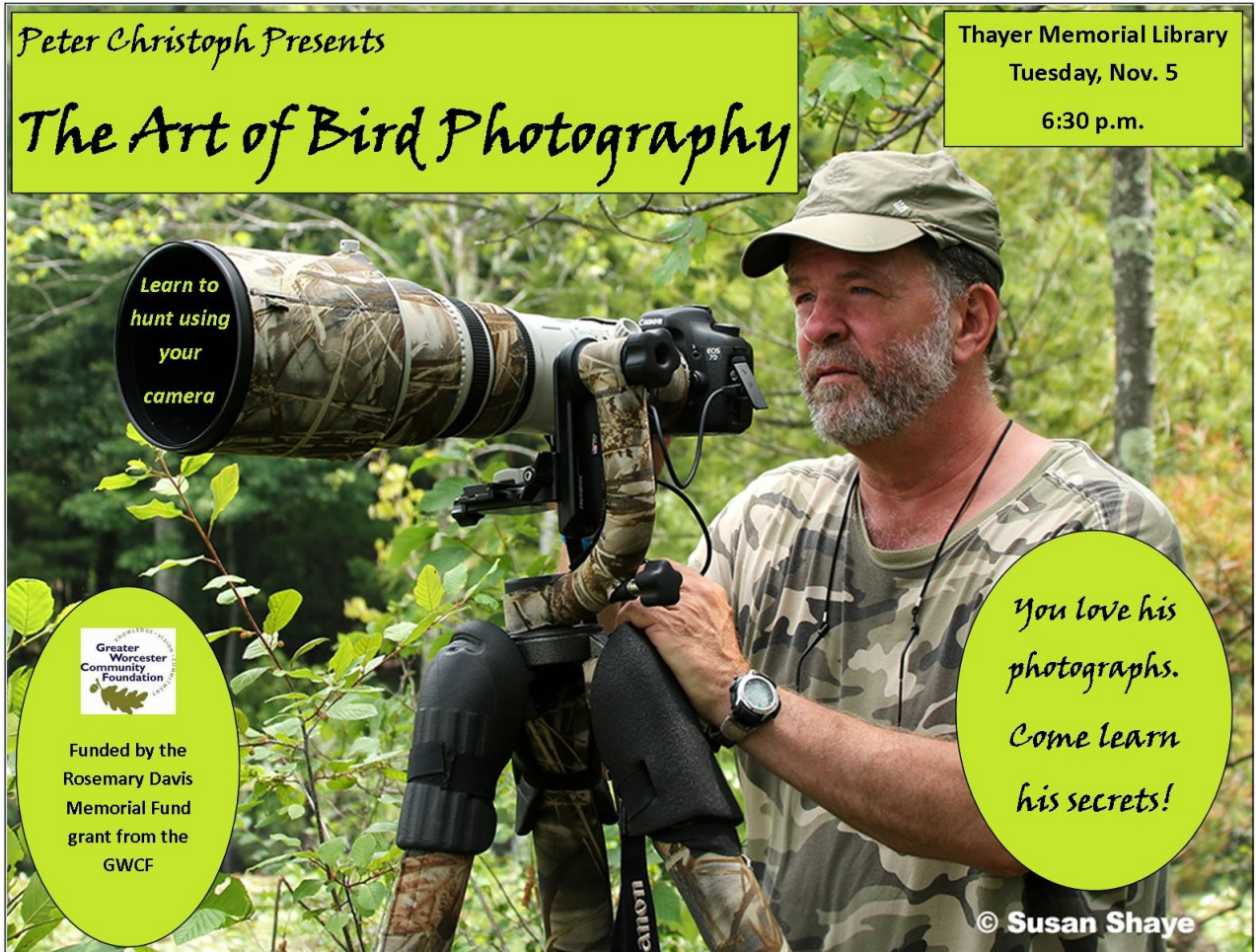

Currently the Town of Lancaster currently own a 2001 Elgin street sweeper which was purchased at the cost of \$97,882.00 with chapter 90 funds, which currently has 2,742 engine hours. To calculate the estimated mileage from hours, you would have to multiply engine hours X 60 (mph). By this formula, it can be concluded the 2001 Elgin sweeper has approximately 164,520 miles.

As of now, the 2001 sweeper is in need of repairs, the estimated cost is anywhere is from \$6000 to \$8000 out of the DPW operating budget. The conveyor belt, drive motors, and bearings are all beyond the life expectancy from a vehicle of this age and miles. Over the past 2 years cost of repairing this sweeper has run approximately \$2,200.00 per year.

Some of the mechanical parts of the power take off, which drives all moving parts, are worn out and fluids are leaking that needs to be filled every time the sweeper is used. The estimate provided (\$6000 to \$8000) is for parts only. This doesn't include additional problems discovered during these repairs that might require additional parts and hardware that are unforeseen.

The DPW has done a great deal of preventative maintenance on this machine, as they do with all DPW vehicles. A road sweeper has numerous moving parts that require on going repairs and maintenance. This sweeper was also involved in a motor vehicle crash in 2006. Although repairs were completed the vehicle was deemed safe to operate there was always adjustments need to the sweeper to ensure it was operating at 100% efficient and sweeping was completed to what the residents have become to expect. **To read more go to:**
