To see if the Town will vote to increase the appropriation of the Solar Enterprise $\$ 60,567$ (Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars) to a total of $\$ 159,222$ (One Thousand Fifty Nine Two Hundred Twenty Two Dollars) from the Renewable Energy Enterprise Fund to finance the operation of the Landfill Solar Array for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015 (detail below), or act in any manner relating thereto. The operating expenses for the Renewable Energy Enterprise Fund are entirely funded by solar array revenue.
