The important note here is that there will be no motor vehicle inspections


during this time. Also, AAA locations will be unable to process RMV services and all online services will be unavailable.





As we enter our 31st year, the members of the Executive Board and I are excited to present our four programs for the 2019-2020 season.



CHICKEN BYLAW



Lancaster Zoning Use Regulation 220-8.1 Accessory uses Section GG

Lancaster Code for Raising of Chickens under 5 Acre Lot

Allowed under zoning district Residential Only.

The raising and keeping of up to six chickens (common domestic female chicks and hens, but no roosters) for non-commercial use by the residents of any lot with a minimum area of .90 acre or more. The chickens must be kept in a coop or pen enclosure that is no less than 20 feet from any lot line, 50 feet from any existing dwelling, and 1600 feet from any existing commercial poultry farm producer.

Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (Climate Change) Public Listening Session and Report

Monday, November 18th, 2019

The Town is working with BETA Group, inc. and key stakeholders to determine the Town's vulnerabilities to climate events. We will use this information to develop an assessment and action plan. This plan will allow the Town to be better prepared in our response to these events. Communities who complete the MVP program become certified as an MVP community and are eligible for MVP Action grant funding and other opportunities. The town held an invited stakeholder workshop on October 7th and October 9th, and is holding a final public listening session and report to be held on Monday, November 18th, 2019 from 5:00-6:00pm in the Nashaway Room in the Prescott Building at 701 Main Street.
