Online Payment changes coming soon

MCC, our on line payment service for Real Estate tax, water, and excise bills, has been purchased by Invoice Cloud. Therefore, Lancaster is in the process of launching a new online billing and payment solution with Invoice Cloud. Invoice Cloud offers more ways to view and pay your real estate, water, and excise bills, plus the addition of "pay by text". Residents can receive and view bills electronically, make a payment with credit/debit card or e-check, and choose to go paperless. A quick, one-time payment can be made without registering or you can create an account to enjoy more features like setting up automatic payments, saving payment information for later use, and viewing history.

- Go Paperless get your bills via email
- Save time with automatic payment options:
 - o Auto Pay automatically pay the invoice amount on the due date

How about a water bottle holder for your favorite Pickleball holder or a Wine Gift Bag (also great to take that special bottle to watch a sunset on the beach).

Plarn is plastic yarn. Using plastic bags headed for landfills, we can crochet them into useful projects like messenger bags, beach bags, water bottle slings, wallets, sleeping mats for shelters, purses, and more!

Supplies: at least 20 clean plastic grocery bags, a pair of scissors, a crochet hook size at or close to 6mm (J-10) (or let us know and we will borrow a hook for you to use.) Extra bags will be available.

Laura Bogart will teach you to follow a crochet diagram including rounds, double crochet. If you are brand new to crochet, you are welcome to observe, or use YouTube to learn how to crochet before attending. Knitters can easily learn these basics. Heather Pierson Trio








