Worship and Religious Education at 10am:

October 1: "Our Catholic Roots - What We Share with Roman Catholicism." As our children continue to explore world religions (including a recent visit to St. John's Catholic Church in Clinton), we will reflect on the roots and traditions we Unitarians share with Catholicism. We also celebrate communion with an open table to which all are invited.

In the religious education classes the younger children will hear a story entitled: Mama's Saris. 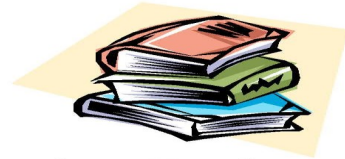
Mindfulness and Society: Practicing in Uncertain Times
